Indian Defence Milestones

- India's defence exports reached a record high of ₹23,622 crore (approximately USD 2.76 billion) in FY 2024-25, marking a 12.04% increase from the previous year. The government aims to achieve an annual defence production target of ₹3 lakh crore by 2028-29.
- Over 500 strategically important defence items brought under positive indigenization list.
- Simplified Procurement Procedures introduced under The Defence Acquisition Procedure (DAP) 2020
- SRIJAN Portal fosters collaboration between Defence Public Sector Undertakings
- iDEX Scheme supports innovation and startups (MSMEs and individual innovators) in the defence sector
- 20% of India's total defence production is contributed by private sector and is fast growing India aims to become a major defence exporter. The target for defence exports is set at ₹50,000 crore by 2028-29.
